Who was Holy Martyr Theodore of Pergia (138-61)?



Holy Martyrs Theodore, his mother Philippa, Dioscorus, Socrates and Dionysius suffered during the reign of the emperor Antoninus Pius (138-161) in Perge, Pamphylia. Robust, healthy young men were conscripted for military service; when Theodore and others came before the military commander Theodotus he ordered the youth to offer sacrifice to idols, but the martyr submitted neither to persuasion nor threats. Theodotus had him placed on a red-hot plate and poured liquid tar on him. Suddenly, there was an earthquake, and a torrent of water gushed forth from the ground and extinguished the fire. Theodore remained unharmed, and gave praise to God. The commander thought it was sorcery; Theodore suggested that he test the power of his gods by putting the pagan priest Dioscorus through

the same trials. Rather than call for help of Zeus, Dioscorus replied that he believed in Christ and was prepared to throw the idol of Zeus into the fire. The military commander commanded him to get on the heated plate. Dioscorus fell at the knees of Theodore, asking that he pray for him. He got onto the plate, crying out: "I thank You, Lord Jesus Christ, that You have numbered me among Your servants. Accept my soul in peace." Then he died, delivered from terrible torment. They continued to torture Theodore. They tied him to wild horses, which began to run. At the city walls the horses fell down and collapsed, and Theodore remained unharmed. Two soldiers, Socrates and Dionysius, saw how a fiery chariot came down from the heavens to Theodore, on which the martyr was carried off. The astonished soldiers shouted: "Great is the God of the Christians!" Soldiers seized them and the next day threw them into a fiery furnace with the martyr Theodore. But a heavenly dew cooled the furnace, and the saints remained and reported that the three youths were unharmed. St. Theodore's mother, Philippa, encouraged the martyrs in their act. The military commander to differ to offer sacrifice to the idols. St. Philippa said that when her son was born it was revealed to her that he would be crucified for Christ. Hearing this, the military commander commanded them to crucify St. Theodore, and to cut off the heads of the other martyrs. St. Theodore hung on the cross three days, offering prayers to God and he then died.

Testament. In one of the many unique stories of the Fourth Gospel not found in the Synoptics (Matthew, Mark or Luke), Jesus reveals himself as Messiah to this woman of Samaria and talks with her about the "water that I will give will become ... a spring of water gushing up to eternal life."

In the early days of His ministry, Jesus travels back and forth between Galilee and Jerusalem, and must pass through Samaria. The Samaritans were outcast Jews because they were not subject


